Changing TIMES....Unchanging TRUTH

Warm Greetings in the precious name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. I would like to share my simple thoughts to you and highlight an important truth from three different incidents.

The first incident is from the life of Jesus Christ. Two thousand years ago, God sent His Son Jesus Christ, into this world to love, heal and forgive mankind. Yet, mankind hated

Him, condemned, spat on Him, and nailed Him to die on the Cross of Calvary. Though we as sinners did this to Him, yet Jesus Christ chose to forgive us. This is obviously evident from His last words on the Cross: "Father forgive them for they do not know what they are doing" (Luke 23:34)

The second incident is from the life of Stephen, a disciple of Jesus Christ. Stephen loved Jesus with all his heart but some of the religious Jews hated him, caught him and stoned him to death. While they were stoning him, Stephen prayed:" Lord Jesus, receive my spirit, then he fell on his knees and cried out "Lord do not hold this against them and when he said this, he died. (Acts 7: 59)

The third incident is from the life of Gladys Staines, wife of the martyred Australian missionary Dr. Graham Staines. This wonderful couple, blessed with three children came to Orissa, India to share the redeeming and forgiving love of God. This humble family loved, cared and lived among lepers, but certain Hindu fanatics hated him and his work, and one day they burnt Dr. Staines and his sons alive while they were asleep in his car. The police finally caught the culprits and they asked Mrs. Staines what should be done to them and her reply was "I forgive them, set them free". Her response shocked the entire world. Inspite of the tragic death of her beloved husband and children, she wished that the police authorities would free the murderers. Instead of being bitter and unforgiving, she chose to forgive.

In these three different incidents: the persecuted Christ-The Son of God, The persecuted disciple-Stephen and Gladys Staines- the wife of the persecuted missionary-Graham Staines, we learn that though these people suffered persecution, they chose to forgive the people who persecuted them. Jesus Christ came to reveal the true and unchanging love of God. God who loves us with an everlasting love is the same vesterday, today and forever. Time may change, but the unchanging truth is that, God is loving and forgiving. This truth will remain forever. This truth was revealed and demonstrated to us by Jesus on the Cross. Similarly, we as God's children must learn to forgive others, as God- The Father and Christ forgave us.

To experience forgiveness, we need to confess our sins and we confess through prayer. The Holy Scriptures teach us that "when we confess our sins, God is faithful and just to forgive our sins" (1 John 1:9). When you pour your heart at the feet of Lord with tears and submit your supplications in His presence, He will pour His blessings proportionally in your life. The more you pour sincere tears of deep love, the more you will reap the abundant blessings from God. Dear child of God, not a single drop of your tear that you shed before God will be wasted. Each single drop is accounted by God and it brings its own blessing.

Jesus Christ, Stephen and Gladys Stains grasped and enjoyed the rich love of God and its power. Friends, God's love is powerful. It has the power to change you. Once you experience God's forgiving love, your life will be impacted by it and you will bear fruit. Forgiveness is the fruit of God's love. After reading this short article, I pray that The Holy Spirit will bring to your remembrance the people whom you need to forgive in your life. Confess your sins to Christ and The Father's love will enable you to forgive those people who have wronged, hurt or betrayed you. Sometimes all we need to do is to pray, confess and forgive others as God has forgiven us. As a church, let us forgive one another and move on.
